REASONS FOR AWARD :-

The Executive Engineer, Public Works Division, Miraj under his letter No. GAD/Misc-8230 dated 17/10/1981 has initiated a proposal for acquisition of lands for construction of bridge across Warna River village Aitawade, Tahsil Walwa, Dist. Sangli. The Collector of Sangli under his endt. No. LAQ/SR-1440 dated 23/11/1981 forwarded this proposal to this office to start the land acquisition proceedings. The purpose of acquisition as stated in the acquisition proposal is in the interest of public in general and hence it is a public purpose as defined in the Land Acquisition Act, 1894.

AREA :-

of the Acquiring Body and Survey Department. The result of measurement work has been mentioned in the Plane Table sheet and Joint Measurement Certificate. The interested persons have not raised by objection to the Joint Measurement work carried out. Therefore, the area was shown in the joint measurement certificate in respect of lands under acquisition is taken as true area for the purpose of awarding compensation.

HOTICES AND OWNERSHIP:

Public notice under section 4(1) and under section \$\(\) 9(1)(2) after publication of notification in the gazette were duly published in the village Tahsil Office as well as on the lands under acquisition. Similary individual notices under section 4(2) and 9(3)(4) were also duly served on the persons known or belived to be interested in thelands under acquisition.

V.F. VII-XII of the lands under acquisition perused and the entries in the V.F. VII-XII are taken as base for deciding the ownership of the lands under acquisition for awarding compensation to the interested persons.

ELTUATION AND DESCRIPTION 1-

The lands under acquisition are Bagayat land, 1t

adjucent to the present gaothan area.

My predecessor has inspected the site on 16/2/1984.
There are no structures in the acquired lands.
CLAIMS:-

The interested persons Shri Bapu Lakhu Pawar, Shri Shri Pandu Aba Patil.

Hahadu Narayan Pawar/filed the claim at the rate of Rs. 40,000/
per hectre at the time of enquiry under section 9(3)(4) of the

Land Acquisition Act, 1894. They have not produced any documentary

evidence in support of their claim hence same has been rejected.

EVIDANCE BY THE ACCUIRING BODY:-

The Acquiring Body has not produced any oral or documentary evidence in respect to market value of the lands under acquisition.

PANCH VALUATION :-

In the panchanama dated 29/11/1983 made the valuation of the lands under acquisition at the rate of Rs. 20,000/- per hectre. The valuation made is according to the estimation of panchas. The panchas have not produced any evidence either oral or documentary in support of their estimation. The panchanama will not therefore, be useful for fixing valuation of the lands under acquisition, I therefore, discard the panchas valuation.

VALUATION:-

The lands under acquisition are having an assessment from Rs. 7-00. In view of this the lands under acquisition is grouped in only one group. To determine the value of lands we have got the following sales for consideration.

In this case section 4 notification has been published on 27/10/1983 in Maharashtra Govt. Gazette Pune Division. The lands under acquisition are jirayat and adjucent to village gaothan. The sale at S.Nos 1,2,3,4 and 6 are high class of land land hence these sales have been discarded. Now only one sale at Sr. No. 5 remain for consideration. This sale transaction of Gat No. 32 1860 is near about the acquired land. The price of agriculturial lands increasing day by day. Taking into considers—tion the price of land under acquisition is fixed of Rs. 10,000, per hectre.

POT KHARAB LAHES :-

From theperusal of the Joint Measurement Certificate & Plan it is seen that no Pot Kharab lands are coming under acqui-sition hence valuation of Pot Kharab lands does not arise.

TALS TREES, STRUCTURES WELLS ETC.

At the time of site inspection it is seen that there are trees and structures in the lands under acquisition hence valuation on account of trees and structures does not arise.

FENCING COMPOUND VALLS:-

Fencing or compound walls are not constructed by the interested persons in the lands under acquisition. No compensat amount is therefore, to be awarded on this account.

INAM LANDS:

From perusal of V.F. VII-XII of the lands under acquisition it is seen that the Gat No. 1865 is Inam Class VI of Patil Inam. The land in question is to be regaranted. Nazarana amoun equal to 20 times the Assessment should be credited to Govt.

There are no tenants on the lands under acquisition.

From the perusal of V.F. VII-XII of the lands under acquisition there is no encumbrances.

Possession of the acquired lands are not taken by the acquiring body under provision of Land Acquisition Act same will be handed over to the Acquiring Body at the time of payment of final compensation.

DAMAGES ON ACCOUNT OF SEVERANCES INJURIOUS EFFECTION AND LOSE OF

The interested persons are not entitled to receive compensation on these factors as no severances are formed on ALL account of present acquisition nor there is no loss of business or goodwill and injurious effection.

SOLATIUM.

The statutory solatium of 15% should paid to the interested persons for compulsory nature of acquisition as per section 23(2) of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894.

MEASUREMENT & PERCANTAGE CHARGES :-

This is Govt. Project hence measurement and percentage charges are not leviable from by the Acquiring Body.
